On April 20, ExxonMobil visited The University of Texas at Austin to commemorate the organizations' longstanding partnership. UT Austin President Gregory L. Fenves hosted a reception in his office to thank the ExxonMobil team for the company's generous support.

XTO Energy President Sara Ortwein presented a check for \$2.4 million to the university. This funding consists of employee donations and the company's matching gift program, and provides support for programs across campus. ExxonMobil's generous 3:1 match is the highest employer match ratio given to UT Austin, amplifying ExxonMobil employees' charitable giving. This gift brings ExxonMobil's total philanthropic giving to the university to over \$67 million, including \$24 million in matching funds.

Other notable guests at the reception included Dean Jay Hartzell from the McCombs School of Business, Dean Sharon Wood from the Cockrell School of Engineering, and Vice President for Development Scott Rabenold. We bid a fond farewell to John Halton, Associate Dean at the Cockrell School of Engineering, and Jimmy Canning, Socioeconomic Manager at ExxonMobil, both of whom are retiring this year.
