Fund The Fringe — Naming Opportunities

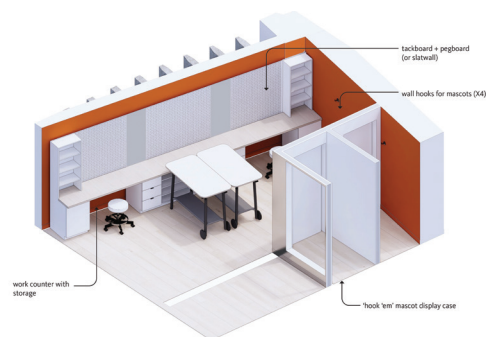

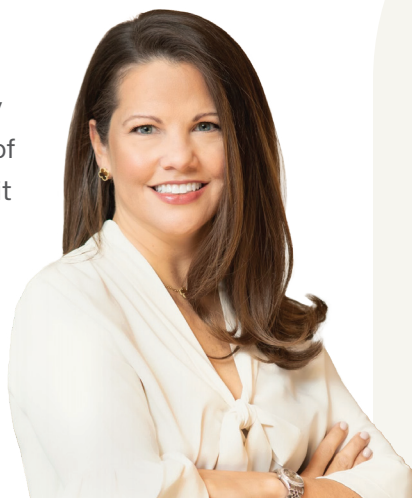
Practice Gym
